High school: “Gheorghe Lazar” Pecica

Title of the lesson: “Let’s travel through the Milky Way”

Aims · To help students extend their vocabulary

- To develop students’ speaking and listening skills
- To develop students’ writing skills

Level: Elementary

Time: 50 minutes

Materials:

 3. Computer/ laptop
 4. Paper or card, scissors, glue, pencils
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Activity 1: Warm-up

Aim: introduction of space topic

Procedure: T divides the class into two teams to play the game. Children take turns to match a word and a picture and a true or false exercise. T is ready to clarify the meaning of useful topic vocabulary such as the Moon and the Sun, comets, asteroids, stars, planets

Circle True or False for these sentences.

1. Mercury is the nearest planet to the sun. True False
2. Venus is the hottest planet. True False
3. Mars is often called the ‘Black Planet’. True False
4. Jupiter is the largest planet. True False
5. Saturn’s rings are made of gas. True False
6. Uranus has got 10 moons. True False
7. Neptune’s strongest winds are 1,200 km an hour. True False



Interaction: T –Ss, S-S

Time: 5 minutes

Activity 2: Story

Aim:

- prepare Ss for the writing task
- develop their speaking skills

Procedure: Before beginning the story, T shows children the picture at the beginning. T tells children that the name of the planet is Fliptune and asks what they think the planet is like (cold and dark) and who lives there (aliens) or if it is a real planet (no).

T pauses the story at various points to ask children what they think will happen next.

T can also pause the story at various points to ask children to describe what they can see in the pictures on the screen.

Interaction: T –Ss, S-S

Time: 10 minutes

Activity 3: Writing

Aim:

- develop Ss' writing skills
- stimulate their imagination, challenge them

Procedure: T divides the class into groups of 4-5 Ss and explains they are going to make their own space story, starting from the title: **“Let’s travel through the Milky Way”**

Interaction: T –Ss, S-S

Time: 20 minutes



Activity 4: Presentation and feedback

Aim:

- develop Ss' speaking skills
- Give feedback

Procedure: When the story is completed, each team presents it. T appreciates their work.

Interaction: T –Ss, S-S

Time: 15 minutes
